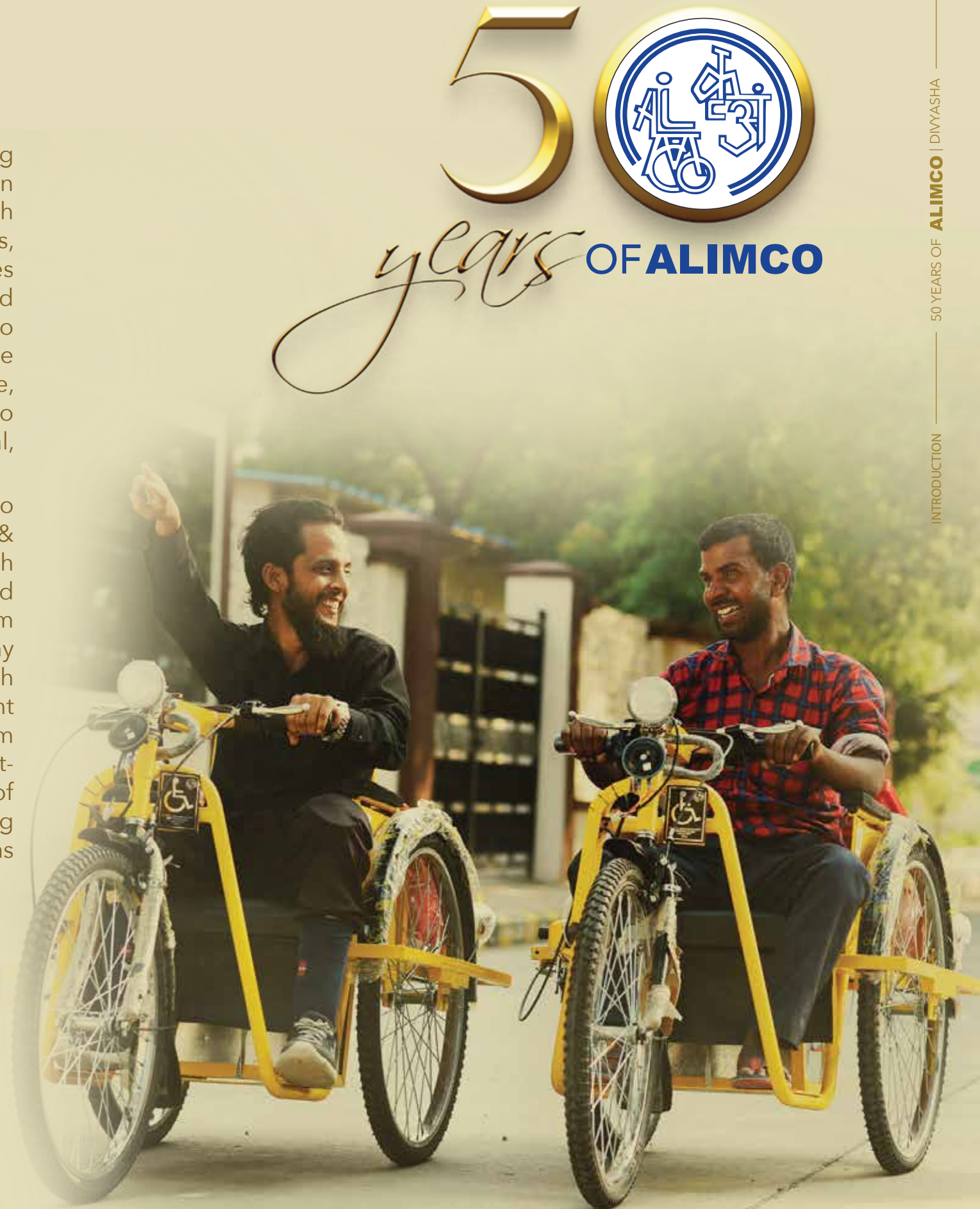

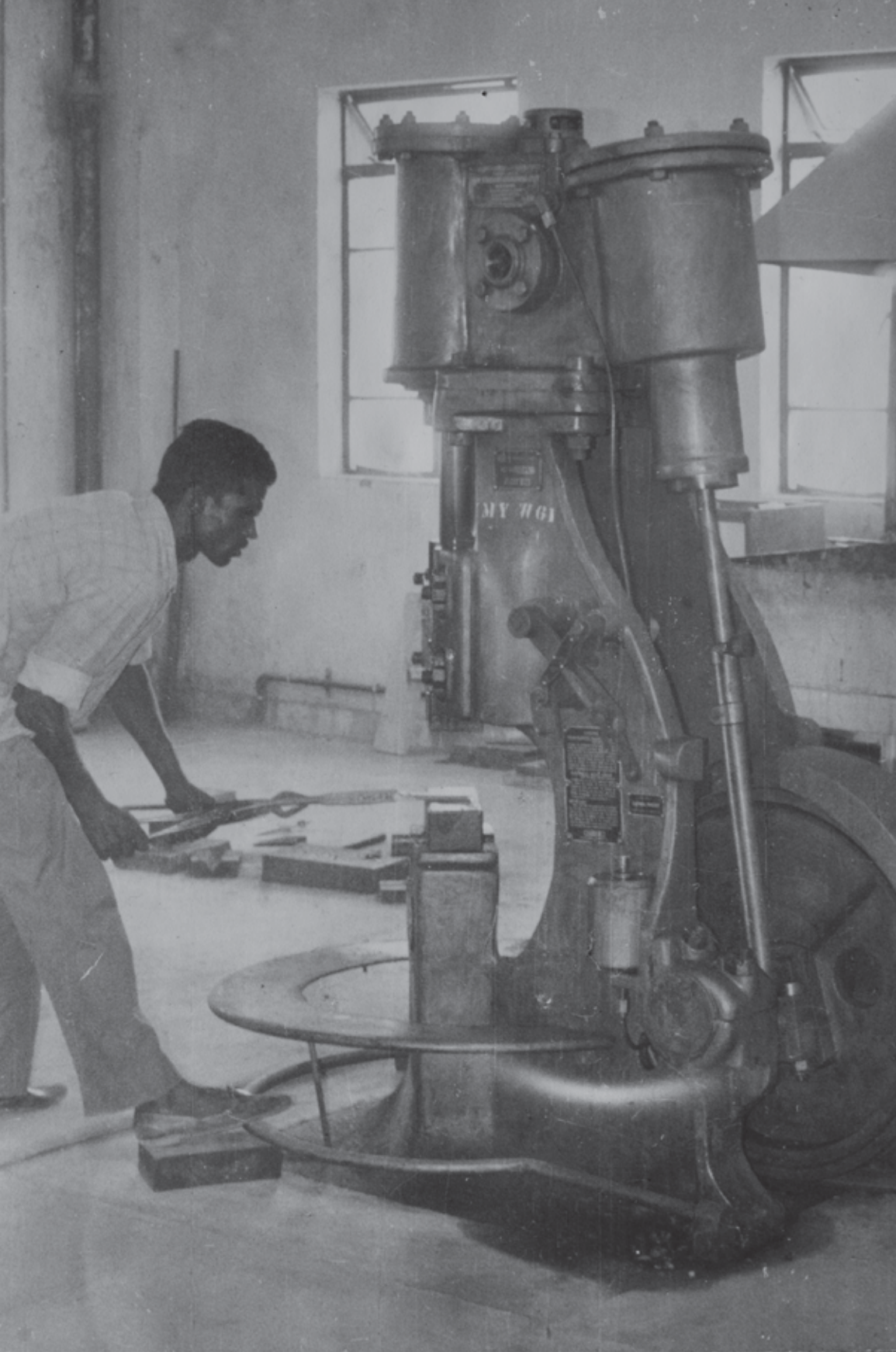

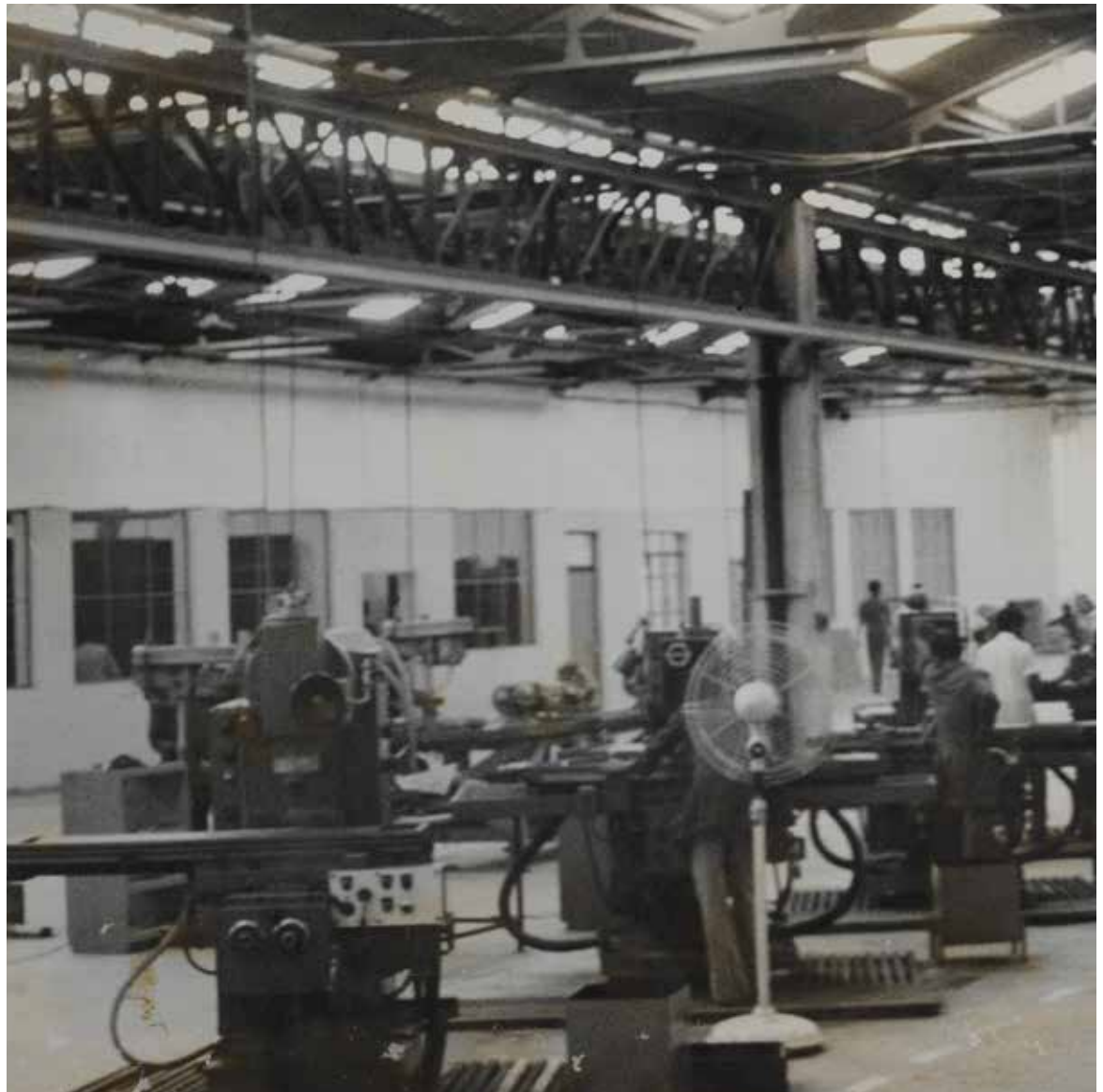

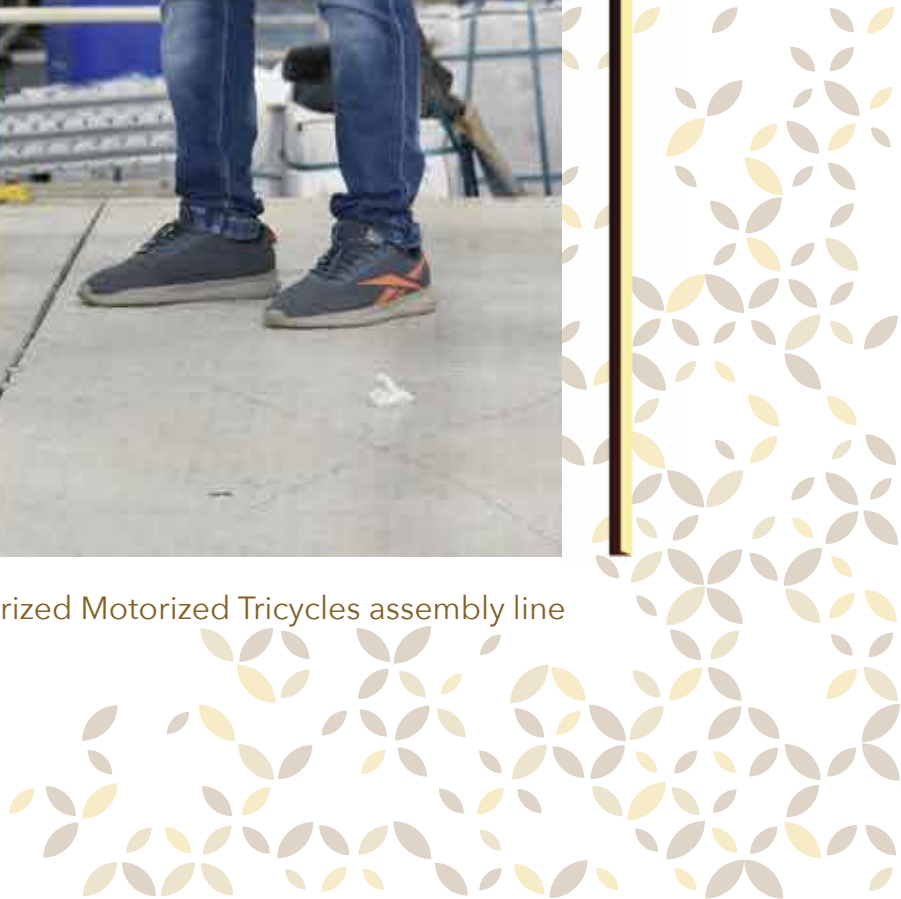

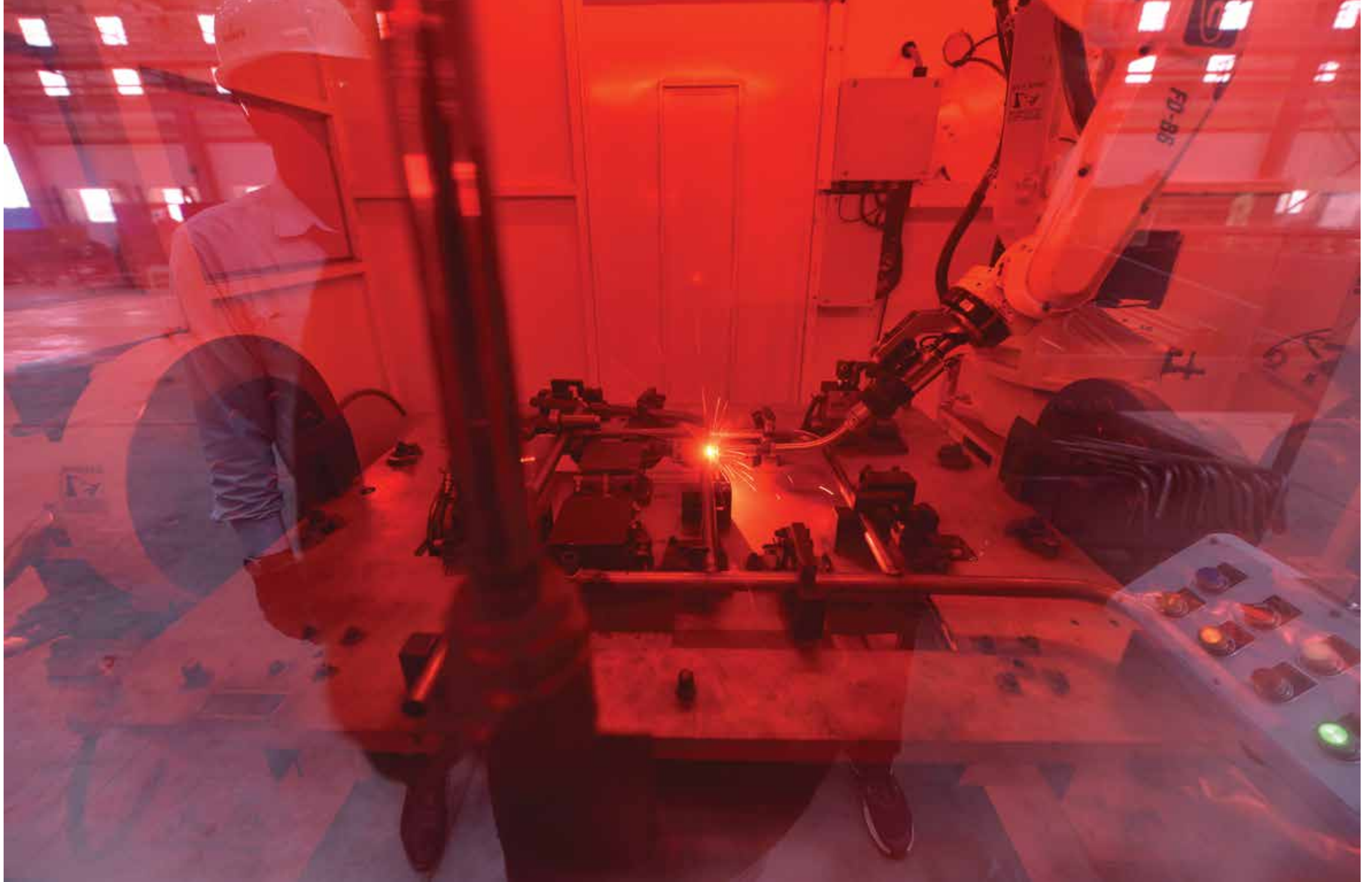

Modernization Project Takes Centerstage



With the Modernization plan of the Corporation getting approved by Standing Finance Committee (SFC) on 21.03.2018, for the upgradation and modernization, ALIMCO's production capacity increased upto many folds as compared to the capacity at pre-modernization time.

- Construction of AAPC Ujjain: Under Modernization plan of ALIMCO, ALIMCO Auxiliary Production Centre (AAPC) at Ujjain was inaugurated on 28th April 2018 by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh. The Plant is operational since then.
- Establishment of High-End Prosthesis Shop (HEPS) at ALIMCO HQ: Under the ToT signed between ALIMCO with M/s Ottobock Healthcare India Pvt. Ltd. HEPS is established with CNC Machines and other high-end Machineries for production of Above & Below Knee joint components.
- Establishment of Township at Kanpur
- Establishment of R&D Building: The facilities in the R&D building immensely improved the capability of ALIMCO in upgradation of the existing product and design and development of new aids and assistive.
- Establishment of ALIMCO's Prosthesis & Orthotic Center (APOC): State of Art Limb Fitting Center was created at APOC to serve the Divyangjans.
- State-of-the-Art G+4 Township was constructed with 24 flats and the same is being used by ALIMCO employees.
- Renovation & Re-modelling of Modern Canteen Facilities for Workers and Executives was done. The canteen has been fully functional since May 2018.
- Work Centers: Modern Work Centers with state-of-the-art machines and facilities were created as a part of the Modernization Project. These Work Centers are dedicated to operations/facilities such as Cutting, Bending, Welding, Surface Plating, Painting, Machining and Assembly.

MOU & ToT DETAILS BY ALIMCO

ALIMCO signed two agreements for “Technical & Consultancy Service” and “Transfer of Technology (ToT)” on 20.05.2015 for mass manufacturing of new generation prosthetic and orthotic devices for Persons with Disabilities in the country at an affordable price.

Further, Transfer of Technology agreement has also been signed with a Trust U.K. on 21.12.2016 for in-house manufacturing of WHO compliance Active folding Wheelchairs. This will help in contributing towards the ‘Make in India’ initiative of the Hon’ble Prime Minister.

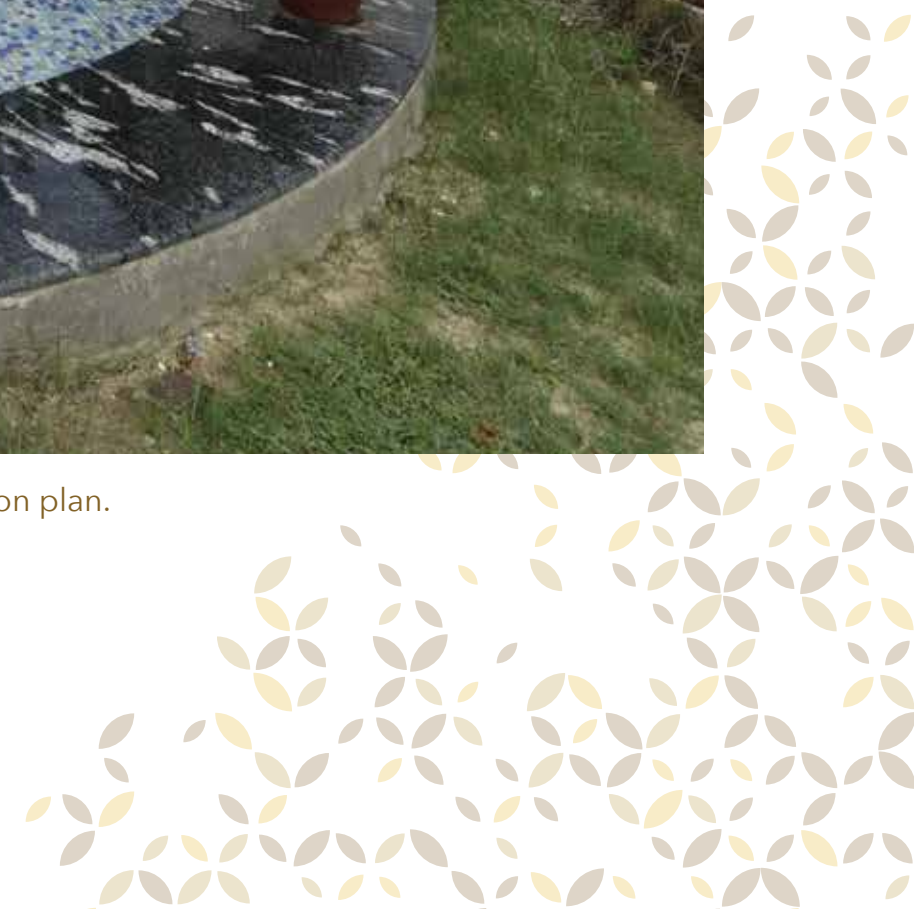

WORK CENTER 1 (Storage & Retrieval System)



It is a storage and retrieval plant. The purpose of this work centre is to store and issue the input raw materials like tubes, sheet, batteries, tools, all brought out parts etc. Installation has been completed.





WORK CENTER 2 (Tube & Sheet Preparation Shop)



It is a metal preparation centre for pipe cutting, bending, notching, equipped with following advance type CNC machines:- i. CNC Laser Sheet Cutting Machines - 2 nos ii. CNC Laser Tube Cutting Machine - 4 nos iii. CNC Tube Bending Machines - 3 nos. Installation has been completed.

WORK CENTER 3 (Surface Preparations Shop)



It is a surface preparation (Nickel Chrome Plating, Zinc Plating, Anodizing and Electro polishing) centre. This shop will have automated system for controlling complete dipping cycle. It will have overhead servo controlled cranes which will guide the batches to respective tanks. Installation has been completed.





WORK CENTER 4 (TIG / MIG Robotic Welding Working Centres)



It is a sophisticated fabrication facility with individual TIG / MIG Robotic Welding working centres. All Robotic cells received. Installation has been completed.

WORK CENTER 5 (Hi-end Prosthesis Shop)



This work centre is a major place for manufacturing prosthetics. The shop is designed here with modern concepts of machining having high end CNC, PU Foaming machines, 3-axis & 5- axis milling machines. All major machines are installed & commissioned.





WORK CENTER 6

Newly established advanced Powder Coating Plant



This work centre is all about powder coating facilities. Installation has been completed.

WORK CENTER 7 (Final Assembly Shop)



It is designed for final assemblies of Wheelchair, Motorized Tricycles and wheels. The Conveyor, lightings, Electric Panels, Work Stations, Overhead Rails have been installed.





WORK CENTER 7B (Warehouse)



The Warehouse is complete in all respects. In addition to the above infrastructure, a 33 KV HT Line substation with independent feeder has been established to give uninterrupted power supply. The entire campus around the new plant has been freshly landscaped.

ALIMCO is an corporation that is working with the mission to restore the Dignity of Persons with Disabilities. Born in the aftermath of historic Indo-Pak conflict of 1971 which left many homeless and a large number of population grievously injured / incapacitated, saw the birth of the Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO) that today stands tall as a Mini Ratna PSU under Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and is proud to have served millions of countrymen requiring artificial limbs and assistive devices to overcome their disability conditions.

In the year 1972, ALIMCO was incorporated under Welfare Ministry and the foundation stone of ALIMCO was laid on 18th November, 1973 by the then Hon'ble Prime Minister Late Smt. Indira Gandhi. The factory was established in Kanpur, the industrial city of Uttar Pradesh and the production started in 1976. Padma awardee Dr. B Sankaran was appointed as the first Chairman of the corporation.

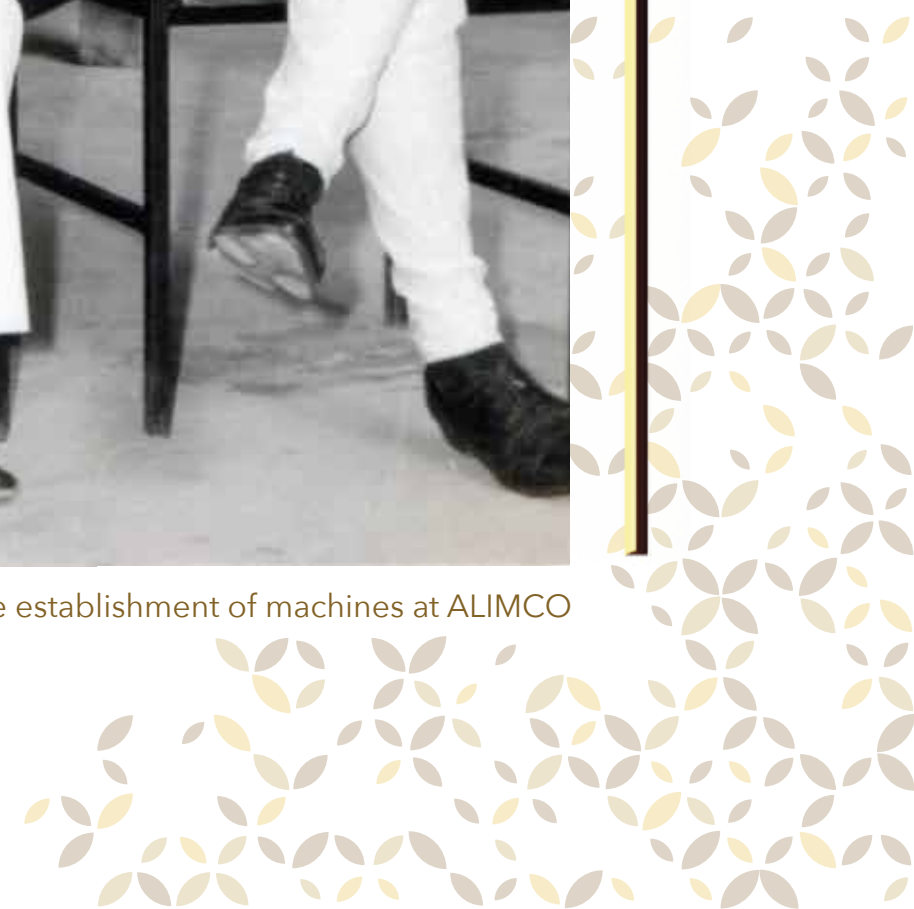

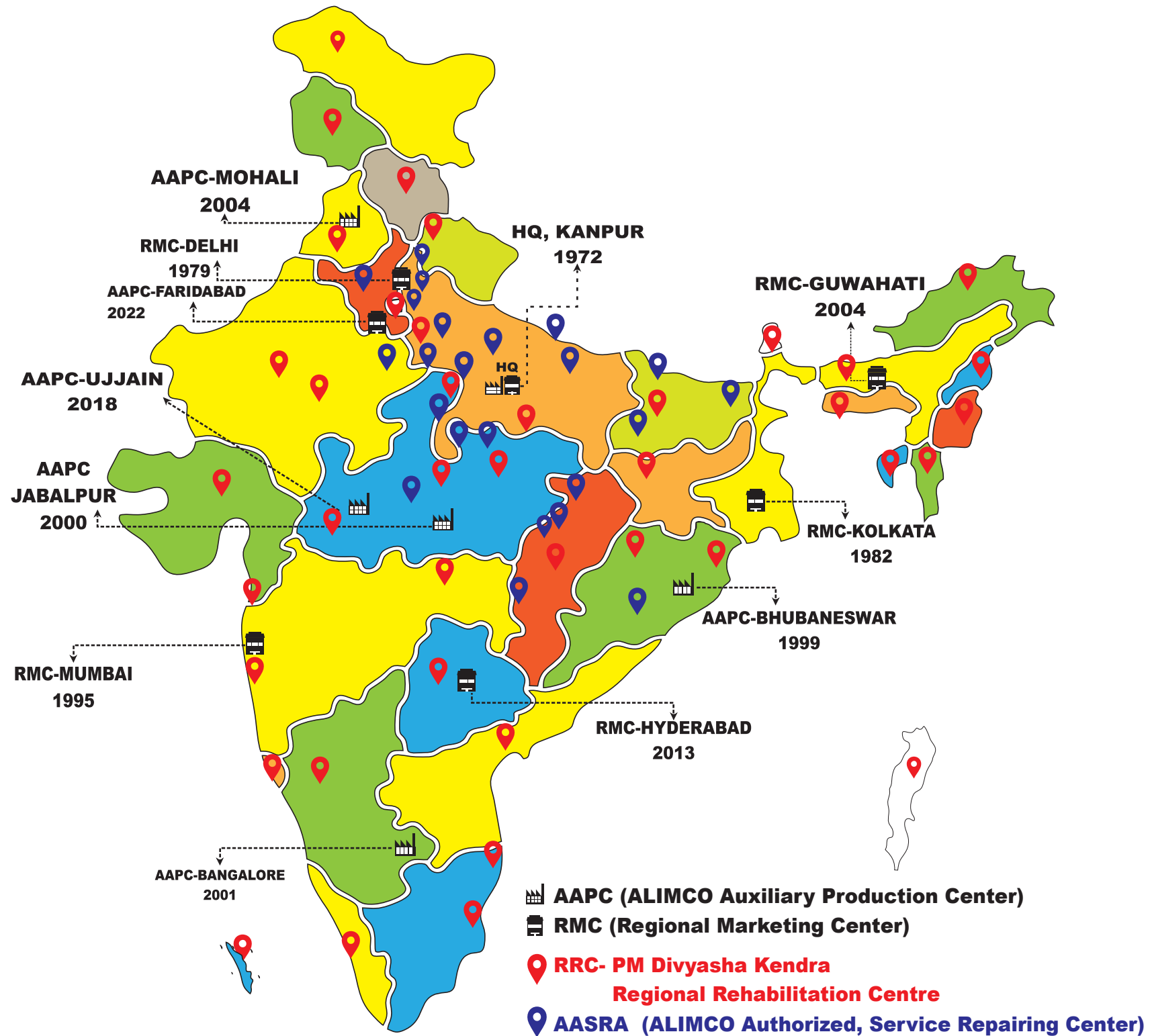

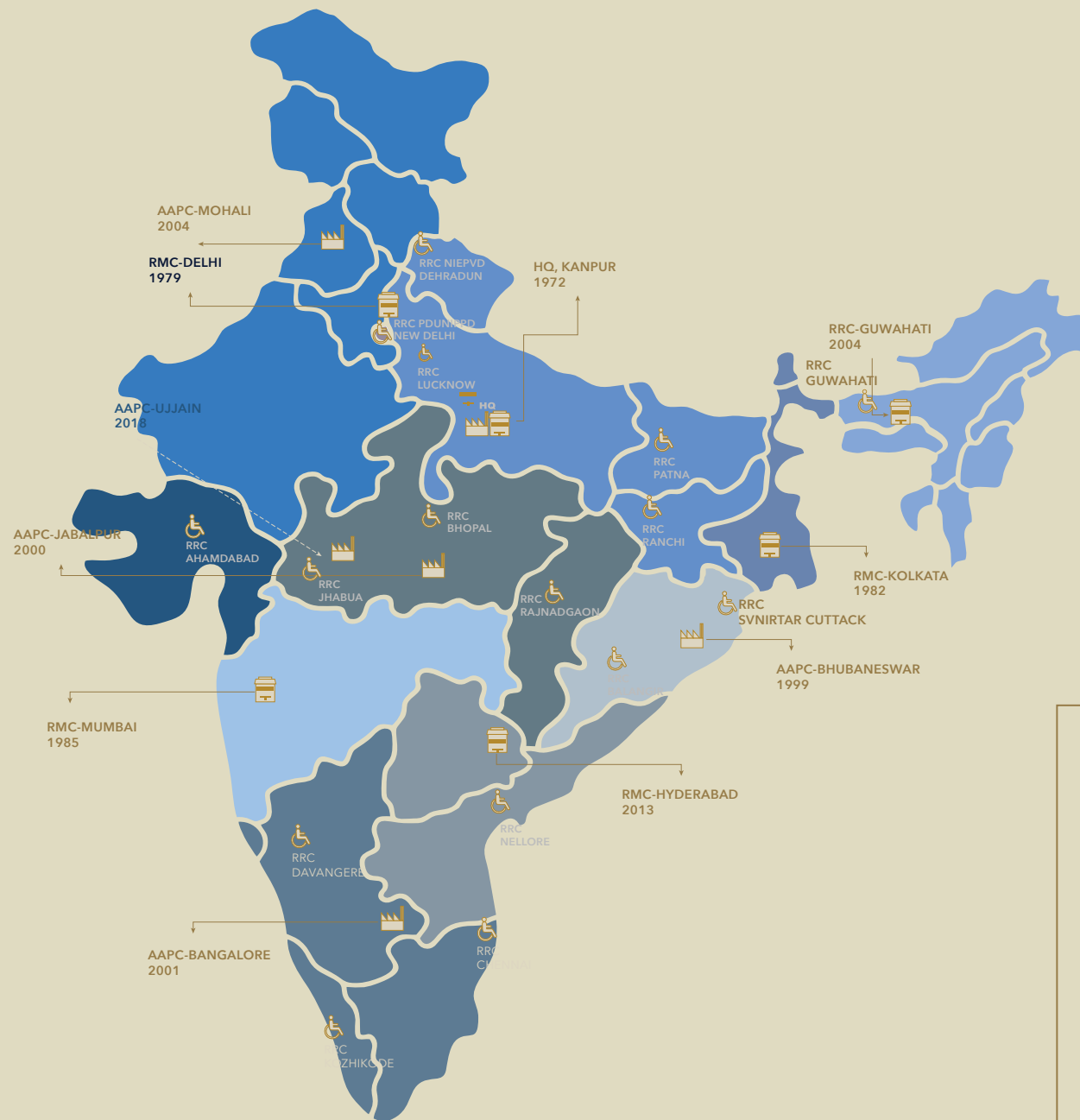

The Illustrious Journey

1972 to 1982

ALIMCO saw the light of day in the year 1972, when the NATIONAL DEFENCE FUND granted Rs 4 crore and 44 acre land was spared by IIT Kanpur, to facilitate its establishment. It was National Industrial Development Corporation Limited, that was at this time consultant for plant and machinery needed to set up ALIMCO. Initially National Institute for Prosthetic and Orthotic Training (NIPOT) was set up for training and research, that was conducted to develop Limb Fitting centres. In the years 1977-1978 new products, wheelchair, crutches, tools and devices for making artificial limbs and artificial leg (Lower extremities prosthetics) were developed and produced. In 1981 the scheme was launched for the purchase and fitting of AIDS and Appliances under ALIMCO's Aids and Assisted Devices (ADIP) for Assistance to Disabled /Divyangjan.

1983-1984

This was truly the MILESTONE YEAR when several new products were developed. These included the Tricycle that was hand propelled and liver driven. Diversification into development and manufacture of products for other disabilities too started with the Braille Slate, Plastic Cane for Blinds.

1984-1985

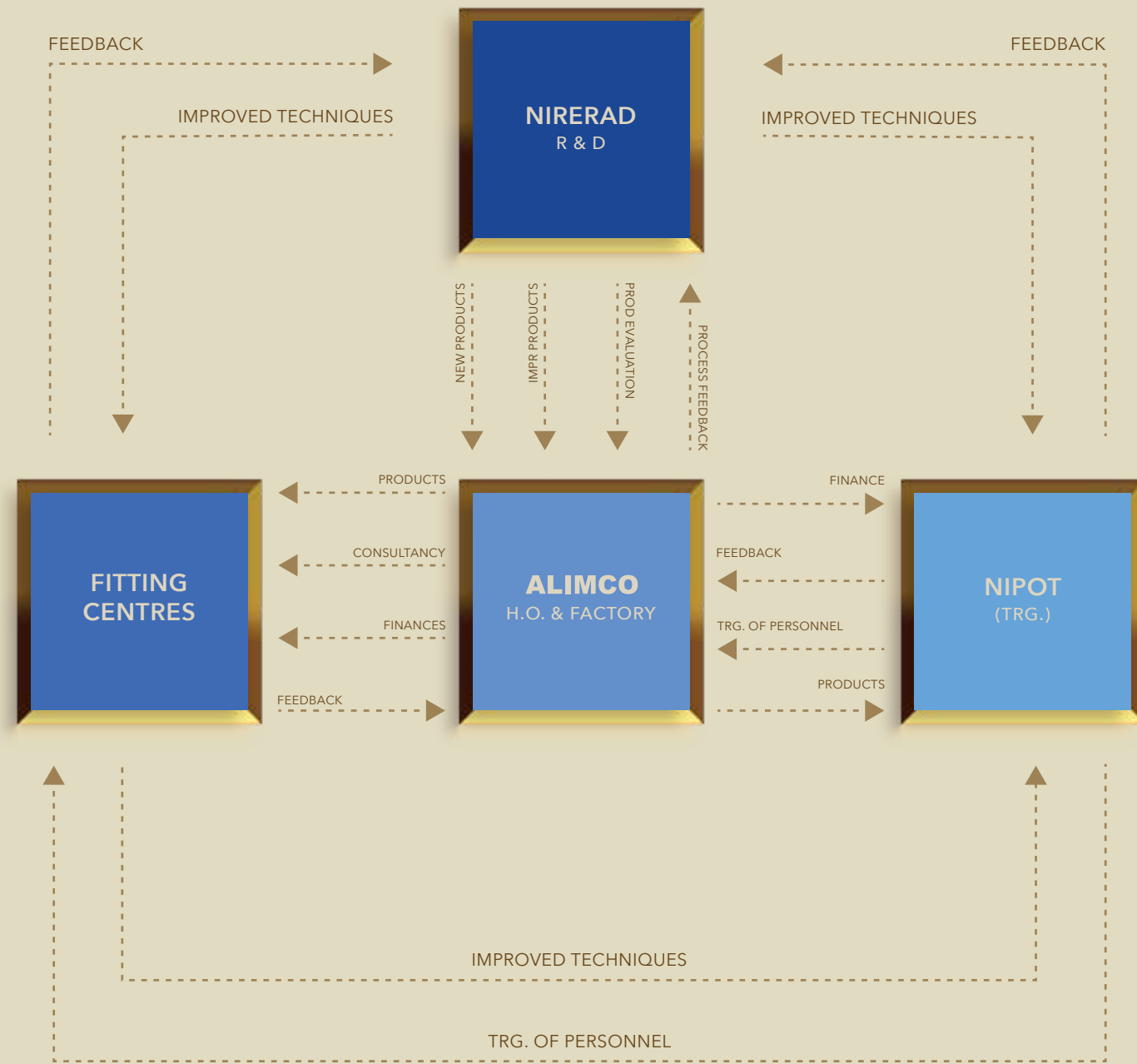
This was the year when hand operated, liver driven wheelchairs were manufactured at ALIMCO.

1985-1986

Production of Cervical Collars happened in this year.

INITIAL WORK PROFILE



1988-1989

This was the landmark year when the Janata Tri-Wheeler was successfully launched and distributed among 200 valued customers.

1991-1992

The '90s saw a spate of product enhancement. The design of wheelchair for Indian Railways and National Airport Authorities was accepted by the Railways and Indian Airlines.

1996-1997

This year saw the wheelchair, both standard and deluxe for adults, acquire the Indian Standards Institution (ISI) mark.

1997-1998

ALIMCO started manufacturing ISI mark wheelchairs.

1998-1999

For manufacturing hearing aid, Regional Production Centres were planned for Bhubaneshwar, Hyderabad, Abu Road in Rajasthan, Mumbai/ Pune. In addition to this, in Oct 1999, 6000 MT of food supplies were dispatched to Super Cyclone hit Orissa areas.

2000

Telescopic handy walking stick for orthopedically handicapped was added to the product range and the commercial production of Hearing Aids that was started in 1999, was taken forward.

2001

This was the year of the catastrophic Bhuj earthquake. Within 7 hours of its occurrence, 350 wheelchairs, 1900 crutches, 750 elbow crutches, 500 walking sticks, 250 cervical collars and 50 braces were delivered to the quake victims by ALIMCO. Also, a gift cargo containing 400 MT of food, medicine, hospital and relief supplies were sent on priority for those hit by the Gujarat earthquake.

2001-2002

Bhubaneswar Auxiliary Production Centre (APC) became functional with the production starting of wheelchairs, tricycles in 2001 July. In the meanwhile, in Jabalpur, possession of allotted land was done with 2003 as deadline for production to start there. APC in Punjab was on the anvil by then and land was provided for APC in Bangalore.

2002-2003

The Offset Printing Machine got commissioned. Pocket-type hearing aid with telecoil and also behind the ear (BTE) was developed. ALIMCO also went on to add the prototype of motorized battery driven wheelchair, triwheeler/ tricycle in its long manufacturing list. ALIMCO provided artificial limbs to 1000 landmine blast victims.

2003-2004

The Jabalpore unit became functional and started wheelchair and tricycle production. In Kanpur, a new device Rollator or wheeled walker that consists of a frame with three or four large wheels, handlebars and a built-in seat, was developed. It is in fact a mobility aid for the elderly and the bodily weak.

ADIP got a further boost with the motive to provide artificial limbs to school going children, under the Ministry of HRD and Ministry of Social Justice cost-sharing scheme. Under Right to Education (RTE), nobody was to be deprived of education, as the plan was linked to Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan that was later revised as Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA). ALIMCO was the sole implementing agency for this PAN India.

2005-2006

Bangalore unit became functional and bilateral activities too took place, with duty free relief cargo coming from UK, US, Sweden, Germany and Switzerland.

ALIMCO now moved from Ministry of Health to Ministry of Social Justice that was earlier Ministry of Welfare.

Rajiya Bano, (41 years) lives in Tikamgarh District of Madhya Pradesh and since childhood was struggling due to polio infection, with more than eighty percent disability. She came to know about ALIMCO's registration camp under the ADIP Scheme of government of India in her block and got herself registered. She got assessed and just after two months on 14 February 2022 she got her motorized tricycle free of cost in the distribution camp under the ADIP scheme organized in the presence of Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment.

She expressed her gratitude towards the Central government as now she can explore avenues of self-employment by joining one of the skill development programmes run by the government.



SHRAVAN KUMAR

Challenges of Shравan Kumar (32 years), suffering from polio, seemed unsurmountable, till one day Union Minister, Dr Virendra Kumar, happened to meet him, while on a visit to his district. He listened carefully to what Shравan had to say regarding his problems. Thereafter, he requested ALIMCO to provide him a motorized tricycle under the ADIP scheme. According to Shравan, the tricycle not only proved to be his friend but also filled him with courage and motivation to take forward his life.



NAMITA KUMARI

Namita Kumari Pandaba (45 years) of Paikarpalli of Ganjam district in Bhubaneswar says that whatever she could achieve in life, it was due to ALIMCO. Soon after her birth she was affected by polio in both her legs that were left with severe residual paralysis. She visited ALIMCO's unit at Olatpur at the age of four years and ever since then she has been wearing Calipers made out of ALIMCO components on both her legs. Namita pursued her studies and moving with the Calipers and Crutches was able to get a job to make a dignified living. Today she is married to Prava Swain and is a mother too, all due to ALIMCO.



HARDAYAL SINGH

Hardayal Singh's (49 Years) self-confidence was restored after getting Lower Prosthesis (Artificial Leg) under ADIP Scheme. Hailing from Una, Himachal Pradesh, he the sole breadwinner of the family, lost his right leg in a road accident in 2014., One day his brother told him about the distribution camps organized by the Government of India for providing aid and assistive devices for Divyangjan. Subsequently he contacted ALIMCO's Mohali center in Punjab. Right leg above knee amputee Hardayal was examined and fitted with ALIMCO-made above knee prosthesis under the ADIP scheme of Government of India and followed by GAIT training program. Says he, "Now I am planning to expand my work as my confidence is boosted with the Artificial Leg fitted onto me."

Kishor Kumar (20) is visually impaired. A student, belonging to Mohali, he was provided with a Smart Phone at the ADIP distribution camp held in Chandigarh by ALIMCO. Kishor is thankful to both the Government and ALIMCO for making him capable of handling his studies better, as well as staying connected socially.

Yogesh Singh belongs to Auraiya. He lost both his limbs when he got electrocuted at his workplace. He was languishing at home and was unable to do anything.
